### Flexible classes

- Each class requires 55 hours of study. Attending each class for the scheduled 18 weeks will give you 54 hours of attendance. In order to meet the 55 hour requirement, each of your four classes requires one additional hour of flexible learning.
- Each class absence requires either formal documentation, further flexible learning options or supported study sessions on Monday to make up the missing class time.
  - Formal documents are a medical certificate, statutory declaration or other legal document, along with a special consideration form.
  - Flexible learning options are organised on Google Classroom, or as directed by your classroom teacher.
  - Supported Study is not required, but is highly suggested for students in need of more support for classwork and attendance.
  - Class attendance is measured in hours and each hour in supported study on Monday can be assigned to one class.
- Your enrolment includes an Individual Learning Plan (ILP) for support in your studies, and should be negotiated both at the start of and throughout your studies. Your ILP connects your personal circumstances and learning goals to our college's requirements and goals, including negotiating our flexibility arrangements.
